

## China Yangtze Power H1 electricity output up 7pct YoY

China Knowledge reported that China Yangtze Power Co the country largest listed hydropower corporation and operator of the massive Three Gorges Dam in Southwest China electricity output increased 6.46% YoY to 39.08 terawatt hours in the first half of this year.

The company said in a statement that electricity output of the Three Gorges Dam was 31.92 TWhs in the first six months up by 7.26% YoY. The Gezhouba Hydropower Station produced 7.17 TWhs of electricity during the period, 3.06% more than in the same period of last year.

Last year, the company electricity output surged 95.87% YoY to 100.61 TWhs. The Three Gorges Dam generated 84.37 billion kilowatt hours while the Gezhouba Hydropower Station produced 16.24 billion kilowatt hours in electricity.
